

PROTECT YOUR VEHICLE

- Always lock your car, roll up the windows and take your keys.
- Never leave the car running unattended, even for a short period.
- Park in well-lit and busy areas, which makes it harder for bad guys to break in or steal your car.
- Use an alarm system and/or steering wheel lock device, so your vehicle is less tempting to steal.
- Remove the garage door opener when parked near the house so criminals can't use it to access your house.
- Never leave belongings in your car.

How DenverTrack Works

The vehicle owner preauthorizes DPD access to their vehicle's GPS in the unfortunate event that their vehicle is stolen. Once the preauthorization is completed online:

- The owner calls 911 to report the vehicle stolen
- The owner states that they have filled out the authorization form and gives verbal confirmation that DPD can access the vehicle's GPS information
- DPD is able to track the car in real time and respond to its location with the goal of quickly returning the vehicle to its owner and arresting the thief.

What vehicles are trackable?

Any vehicle with an installed tracking device, including factory-installed devices, after-market devices and GPS & bluetooth tracking devices.

We need your consent

Without express written consent from the vehicle's owner, some car companies will not share real time information with law enforcement without a subpoena, which often takes several business days. This is why it is essential vehicle owners fill out the authorization form prior to their vehicle being stolen.

Is there a program fee?

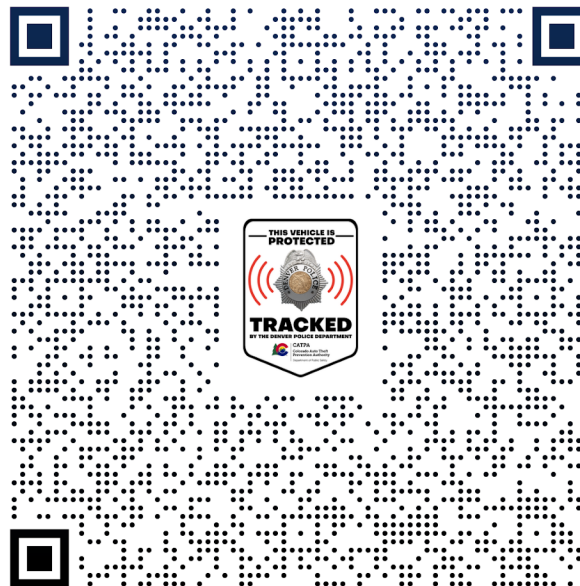
Registration to DenverTrack is free and open to anyone who lives or works in Denver.

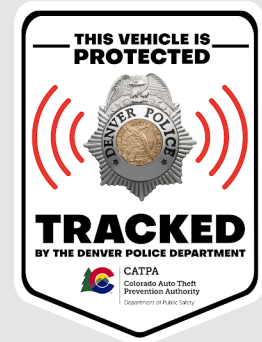
GETTING STARTED

To register for DenverTrack, scan the QR code below or visit denvergov.org/denvertrack.

Once you register, you will be issued two decals associated with the program to place in your vehicle, alerting thieves that your vehicle is protected by DPD.

Place on interior of driver's side windshield where it is visible to vehicle operators.
